Criteria for county team selection (seniors and juniors)

- Eligibility
- Availability
- Capability
- Visibility

Eligibility – the archer must be a fully affiliated, paid up member of DCAA and not have represented another county in the current membership year.

Availability - the archer must be available on the date of the relevant inter county team event.

Capability – the archer must be able to show evidence of being able to shoot the appropriate round / distance. WA1440 or York / Hereford for seniors and age appropriate Metric or Bristol round for juniors.

Visibility – the archer must have shot in either club competitions or open tournaments and supplied details of their scores to the team selection officer. The team selection officer will also look at the scores from various open tournaments, including the most recent DCAA indoor and outdoor championships.

The team selection officer will make his / her recommendations to DCAA Development Group who together with the team selection officer, will make the final selection of the team(s).

The tournament dates are usually:

March (exact date tba) Inter Counties Clout tournament (senior tournament: Derbys, Leics, Lincs, Northants & Notts)

4th Sunday in July the Sydney Bond Memorial shoot (junior inter counties tournament: Derbys, Leics, Lincs, Northants & Notts)

1st Sunday in August the Tri Counties tournament (seniors Derbys, Notts & Warks)

1st Sunday in September for the Thoresby, Bradgate and Boat trophies (senior inter counties tournament: Derbys, Leics, Lincs, Northants & Notts)

Entry to other team events may be arranged during the year.
